



LIUNA Negotiations Update

March 22, 2012

The LIUNA negotiations team met with the district today and proposed our counter offer. Our proposal included the following:

LIUNA indicated that if the CUSD Board of Trustees lowers the number of student instructional days and institutes temporary furlough days for both teachers and administrators, LIUNA agrees to accept temporary furlough days on behalf of all classified staff for those specific student instructional days.

LIUNA requested a joint committee be charged with developing trigger language to plan for restoration of the temporary furlough days.

LIUNA proposed that we meet and analyze the data every 3 months to monitor the deficit reduction plan. LIUNA is actively researching new insurance plans for current classified members and classified retirees. These plans will reduce costs both for the District and our members.

LIUNA also proposed several nonmonetary changes and additions to the contract.

Our next negotiations session is scheduled for next week, when we anticipate getting a response from the district.
